Cows are housed in natural and cross-ventilated freestall barns in deep bedded sand stalls. We also have a single 8 parlor for the hospital cows. We raise all of our replacement heifers on farm along with 500 steers. We have a pasteurizer by the hospital and use that milk to feed our calves 3 times/day. We are focused on making high quality genetic replacements using all sexed and beef bulls for Al breeding. Cow comfort and health are a priority in producing high quality milk to sell. 
