She's also served as a program technician for the USDA's Farm Service Agency, an agriculture outreach specialist for the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture and as a co-developer, instructor, and interpreter of the Dairy Workers Training Modules field researcher for the UW-Extension System.

FLAVIO SILVESTRE, DVM, PhD, is the dairy technical services veterinarian for Zoetis. He received his D.V.M. degree from the Federal University of Minas Gerais in Brazil and was in dairy veterinary practice for 3 years in Brazil, before moving to Florida to participate in the University of Florida International Dairy Farm Fellow program at North Florida Holsteins Farm. He subsequently received his M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Florida department of animal sciences in animal molecular and cellular biology. The emphasis of his research was on hormonal methods and nutraceutical approaches to regulation of postpartum immunity and fertility of dairy cows.

DAIRY OBSTETRICS CARE for the delivering cow

Dr. Julia Hamann will offer practical insights to those managing close-up and maternity pens. In this hands-on training she'll cover the "how" and "why" of first-rate maternity care by addressing the following topics:

- Signs to watch for before, during and after delivery
- Indications of distress during calving
- Protocols for safe, healthy calf deliveries
- Various birthing scenarios and how to determine when assistance is needed
- Safe handling practices for both the handler and cow
- Post-calving care for cows
- Assessing signs of milk fever and ketosis

COLOSTRUM MANAGEMENT for the newborn calf

In this interactive session, attendees will work with serum and colostrum samples and refractometers - and manage their findings. Trainer Flavio Silvestre will also outline:

- The latest cow-side test methods that estimate colostrum quality and evaluate passive-transfer methods in calves
- When and how much colostrum to feed, and the appropriate methods
- Management strategies such as the use of colostrum replacers and heat-treating to reduce bacterial counts present in colostrum
