#### MILWAUKEE METROPOLITAN SEWERAGE DISTRICT (MMSD)

- · The MMSD cleans billions of gallons of wastewater, a combination of stormwater and sewage that enters the system every year. Daily, they can treat more than 630 million gallons of wastewater between the two plants.
- · The Jones Island Water Reclamation Facility, operational since 1926 and
  - designated a National Historic Civil Engineering Landmark in 1974, was one of the first facilities in the world to produce a fertilizer, sold under the name Milorganite<sup>®</sup>, as a byproduct of their water reclamation process.



#### **RODEN ECHO VALLEY, LLC**

- This family-run dairy farm operates about 2.800 acres of land and milks 850 cows just outside West Bend.
- Ever conscientious about water usage, the Rodens manage their land with waterways, grass buffer strips and no-till cover crops.
- Their milk production process includes using water twice - it's

sent through a plate cooler to quickly drop the milk's temperature and then used either to wash down the milking parlor floor or as drinking water for their livestock.
